

## SCHEDULE OF CHARGES EFFECTIVE FROM 1 SEPTEMBER 2018

### SCHOOL FEES

School fees per term for 2018-2019 are as follows:

The School Governors reserve the right to alter the fees at any time throughout the school year.

### Temporary Boarding

A charge of £248.00 per week (4 nights, Monday to Thursday) or £62.00 per night, will be made for temporary boarding by day boys (if bed spaces permit). Prior permission must be sought from and arrangements made with Mr Ian Barker, Housemaster, or in her absence Mrs Lisa Wilkinson, Senior Matron. Please note that if you reserve temporary boarding accommodation, the School will expect to charge for it unless prior cancellation is agreed with the Housemaster or the Senior Matron.

### After School Care/Late Stay

Late Stay is available for all school years after clubs have finished. Timings and charges are listed below.

If pupils are not collected promptly from their after-school club or activity, they will be sent to Late Stay and a charge will be levied.

### **Childcare Vouchers**

Childcare Vouchers are accepted by the School as payment towards all childcare outside of school hours, including holiday activities and sports camps. We are registered with a number of childcare voucher providers.

Please note that childcare vouchers must not be used to pay for private education, except for terms which start before the child reaches age 5

### **REGISTRATION FEE**

Before a child can be assessed and entered for the School as either a boarder or day pupil, a non-returnable registration fee of £100.00 must be paid. (This registration fee does not apply to candidates for Chorister trials).

### **ENTRY FEE**

A returnable entry fee of £600.00 is payable upon written acceptance of a firm place at the School. Half the entry fee (£300) is refunded against the child's first bill from the School; the remaining £300 is refunded against the child's final bill when leaving King's. Entry fees do not apply to those elected at Chorister trials.

### **PARENT TEACHING ASSOCIATION (PTA)**

A PTA membership fee of £10.00 per pupil is charged on a once only basis on every pupil's first school bill.

### **FORMER PUPILS**

#### **KING'S COLLEGE SCHOOL, CAMBRIDGE ASSOCIATION (KCSCA)**

There is a life membership fee of £20.00 for the KCSCA charged (unless instructions are received to the contrary) on a pupil's final bill when leaving the School, or at any time thereafter when wishing to join the Association.

### **EXTRA TUITION**

Extra tuition (private coaching) for all academic subjects will be charged at £44.00 per hour, with pro rata payments falling due for shorter lessons and/or classes with more than one pupil. The need or request for extra tuition must be established directly between parents and teachers, and the teachers giving the extra tuition will bill the parents directly and independently of the School.

### **MUSIC**

Individual music tuition will be charged at £22.00 per half hour lesson, with the expectation that 30 lessons will be given per year. Certain instruments are available for hire from the School (on the basis of availability) at a cost of £34.00 per term including; cello, double bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone, trumpet (cornet), trombone, french horn and tuba and £28 per term for violin, viola and

guitar. A reduced charge of £25.00 per term applies for Pre-Prep pupils. Information about availability and hire prices can be obtained from Rachael Dunlop, Music Administrator.

Where a lesson is missed through illness or through a pupil's fault, the lesson will be charged as the visiting music teacher's presence and travelling time are involved, however, of course, the VMTs make no charge when they, themselves are absent.

There is no charge for group music clubs and activities which are funded by the School.

Choristers are expected to learn two instruments, one of which must be the piano. Piano lessons are paid on their behalf by the College whilst all other instrument lesson fees are billed direct to their parents.

Special arrangements apply within the Pre-Prep where music lessons may be given on a shared basis, or where individual 20 minute lessons are charged at £14.66.

Charges for individual and group music lessons are billed direct to the parents by the music teachers who will send out their accounts, in advance, for each term during which lessons are to be given. Queries relating to music bills should be addressed to individual teachers directly.

James Randle, Director of Music, will assist parents in arranging music lessons, or arranging for the hire of musical instruments where so requested; all queries concerning the Music Department should be addressed to either James Randle or Rachael Dunlop.

#### **LEARNING SUPPORT CENTRE**

Lessons within the Learning Support Centre will be charged at £44.00 per hour.

#### **TENNIS and SQUASH**

Tennis and Squash coaching is charged at £39.00 per hour shared between participating pupils. Charges are billed direct to the parents by the applicable coach.

#### **OTHER EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

A charge may be made for other extracurricular activities, including 'Activity Week' to help offset the expenditure in teaching time and/or materials etc.

### **LEAVERS' PROGRAMME**

A contribution of up to £130.00 will be charged against each participating pupil to help offset the additional costs arising from the Year 8 Leavers' Programme.

### **PAYMENT FOR EXTRAS**

All optional extras and extra tuition will be charged on school bills termly in arrears. Music lessons, Tennis and Squash coaching are billed in advance by the teachers concerned (see above).
