

SCHEDULE OF CHARGES EFFECTIVE FROM 1 SEPTEMBER 2019

SCHOOL FEES

School tuition fees per term for 2019-2020 are as follows:

Boarder	£8,440
Chorister	£2,790
Day Pupil	£5,450
Pre-Prep	£4,290

The School Governors reserve the right to alter the fees at any time throughout the school year.

Temporary Boarding

A charge of £260.00 per week (4 nights, Monday to Thursday) or £65.00 per night, will be made for temporary boarding by day boys (if bed spaces permit). Prior permission must be sought from and arrangements made with the Housemaster, or, in their absence, with the Senior Matron. Please note that if you reserve temporary boarding accommodation, the School will charge for it unless prior cancellation is agreed with the Housemaster or the Senior Matron.

After School Care/Late Stay

Late Stay is available for all school years after clubs have finished. Timings and charges are listed below.

If pupils are not collected promptly from their after-school club or activity, they will be sent to Late Stay and a charge will be levied. If pupils are not collected by 18:00, an additional charge may be made.

Childcare Vouchers

Childcare Vouchers are accepted by the School as payment towards all childcare outside of school hours, including holiday activities and sports camps. King's College School is registered with a number of childcare voucher providers.

Please note that childcare vouchers must not be used to pay for private education, except for school terms which start before the child reaches age 5

REGISTRATION FEE

A non-returnable registration fee of £100.00 is payable on submission of an Application Form for a place at King's College School. This registration fee does not apply to candidates for Chorister trials.

ENTRY FEE

A returnable entry fee of £600.00 is payable upon written acceptance of a firm place at the School. Half the entry fee (£300.00) will be refunded against the pupil's first bill from the School; the remaining £300.00 will be refunded against the pupil's final bill when leaving the School. Entry fees do not apply to those elected at Chorister trials.

PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA)

A PTA membership fee of £10.00 per pupil will be charged on a once-only basis on every pupil's first school bill.

FORMER PUPILS

KING'S COLLEGE SCHOOL, CAMBRIDGE ASSOCIATION (KCSCA)

There is a life membership fee of £20.00 for the KCSCA charged (unless instructions are received to the contrary) on a pupil's final bill when leaving the School, or at any time thereafter when wishing to join the Association.

EXTRA TUITION

The request for additional tuition (private coaching), to be provided by a member of the teaching staff outside of their normal working day, must be agreed by the Head of Department and Deputy Head Academic, prior to it being delivered.

The teacher giving the extra tuition will invoice parents directly and independently of the School. All academic subjects will be charged at £45.00 per hour, with pro-rata payments falling due for shorter lessons and/or classes with more than one pupil.

MUSIC

Music Tuition: Individual music tuition will be charged at £22.50 per half hour lesson, with the expectation that 30 lessons will be given per year.

Instrument hire: Certain instruments are available for hire from the School (on the basis of availability) including: cello, double bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone, trumpet (cornet), trombone, french horn and tuba at a cost of £35.00 per term; violin, viola and guitar at £30.00 per term. A reduced charge of £28.00 per term applies for Pre-Prep pupils. Information about availability and hire prices can be obtained from Mrs Rachael Dunlop, Music Administrator, rdunlop@kcs.cambs.sch.uk.

Missed lessons: Where a lesson is missed due to a pupil's absence or failure to attend, the lesson will be charged, as the visiting music teacher's presence and travelling time are involved. In the event of a teacher being absent, the lesson will be made up if possible or refunded.

Clubs & Activities: There is no charge for group music clubs and activities.

Choristers: Choristers are expected to learn two instruments, one of which must be the piano. King's College pays for piano lessons on their behalf; all other instrument lesson fees are charged directly to their parents.

Pre-Prep: Special arrangements apply within the Pre-Prep where music lessons may be given on a shared basis, or where individual 20-minute lessons are charged at £15.00.

Invoicing: Music teachers will invoice parents directly for individual and group music lessons; invoices will be sent in advance for each term during which lessons are to be given. Queries relating to music bills should be addressed to individual music teachers directly.

Queries: Mr James Randle, Director of Music, will assist parents in arranging music lessons, or arranging for the hire of musical instruments where so requested; all queries concerning the Music Department should be addressed to either Mr Randle jrandle@kcs.cambs.sch.uk, or Mrs Dunlop: rdunlop@kcs.cambs.sch.uk.

LEARNING SUPPORT CENTRE (LSC)

Lessons within the Learning Support Centre will be charged at £45.00 per hour. The LSC tutor will invoice parents directly in advance each term.

TENNIS and SQUASH

Tennis and Squash coaching is charged at £39.00 per hour shared between participating pupils. The coach will invoice parents directly in advance each term.

OTHER EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A charge may be made for other extra-curricular activities, including Activity Week, for Years 5 to 8.

LEAVERS' PROGRAMME

A contribution of up to £130.00 will be charged for each pupil participating in the Year 8 Leavers' Programme.

PAYMENT FOR EXTRAS

All optional extras will be charged on school bills termly in arrears.

Music lessons, LSC lessons, Tennis and Squash coaching are billed in advance by the teachers concerned (see above).
